Rainbow write your numbers from 1-10. <i>(Rainbow writing is when students write with one color, then write over it with a different color, then write over it with a different color until they are satisfied with the colors.)</i></p>	<p><b>Choice 1</b></p> <p>Partner read with your parent/guardian and discuss the importance of listening to your partner.</p>
<p><b>Choice 2</b></p> <p>Count out 10 small objects (pennies, cereal, beans, legos, etc.). Make as many different arrangements as you can. (Example for five are shown below.)</p>	<p><b>Choice 2</b></p> <p>Draw your favorite Letterlander at their house and at least 4 objects you might find at their house. (Ex. Harry Hat Man lives in a hat house with hamburgers, hotdogs, hardwood floors, and hairy dogs).</p>
<p><b>Choice 3</b></p> <p>Make up a song or dance (can be similar to Macarena) to help you and your friends remember how to count from 0-100 counting by tens.</p>	<p><b>Choice 3</b></p> <p>Read a fictional book with your parent and illustrate what the characters are doing in the story to show good citizenship.</p>
