






<p style="text-align: center;">Choice 3</p> <p>Mrs. Swartz made 10 pancakes and 8 sausage links for breakfast. Miss Oliver made 6 pancakes and 4 sausage links for breakfast. When you add Mrs. Swartz and Miss Oliver's breakfast items together, did they eat more pancakes or sausages?
