<p>Choice 2</p> <p>Write all of the partners of ten. (Example: 5 and 5, 4 and 6)</p>	<p>Choice 2</p> <p>Read a nonfiction story to your parents. Discuss what the main idea and key details are.</p>
<p>Choice 3</p> <p>Mrs. Anderson was making strawberry cakes. She used 10 eggs for each cake. She used 80 eggs. How many cakes did she make? (And do you think she could eat them all by herself?)</p> <p>Show your work!</p>	<p>Choice 3</p> <p>Read a book. What are the characters? What would happen if you changed the main character (ex. Goldilocks becomes Superman)? Draw a picture and write about how changing the main character would change the story.</p>
