<p>Choice 1</p> <p>Solve this story problem and show your work!</p> <p>Ms. Barnes had 5 apples. Ms. Esser gave her 5 more. How many apples does she have now?</p>	<p>Choice 1</p> <p>Make a list of 8 words from the "at" word family.</p> <p><i>(for example: at, hat, that...)</i></p>
<p>Choice 2</p> <p>Solve this story problem and show your work!</p> <p>Mrs. Wishy Washy had 12 cows. She gave 7 to her friend Mrs. Funny Bunny. How many cows does Mrs. Wishy Washy have now?</p>	<p>Choice 2</p> <p>Read a fiction or nonfiction book to someone. Tell what strategies you used to figure out any unknown words. <i>(For example: looked at the picture, chunked the word, skipped the word and came back to it, stretched out the sounds...)</i></p>
<p>Choice 3</p> <p>Ms. Oliver had 14 goldfish. Mrs. Swartz gave her some more goldfish and then she had 25 goldfish. How many goldfish did Mrs. Swartz give Ms. Oliver? Show your work!</p>	<p>Choice 3</p> <p>Read a non-fiction book. (You can get one from your teacher if you need one!) Write the main idea of the story and at least 3 key details.</p>
