<p>Choice 1</p> <p>Solve this story problem and show your work!</p> <p>The Crepe food truck at Wiley made 10 crepes. 5 were chocolate and the rest were vanilla. How many were vanilla?</p>	<p>Choice 1</p> <p>Read a book to your parent and use the statement, "somebody, wanted, but, so" to retell the story to your parent.</p> <p>ex) Little Red Riding Hood wanted to take treats to her sick grandmother, but she talked to a stranger, so she took the long way to get to her grandmother's and the wolf almost tricked her.</p>
<p>Choice 2</p> <p>Solve this story problem and show your work!</p> <p>At International Night there were 15 performers. 5 were singing, 3 were dancing and 2 were reading poems. The rest were holding flags. How many were holding flags?</p>	<p>Choice 2</p> <p>Read two books from the same series or have your parent read them to you (<u>Berenstain Bears</u>, <u>Arthur</u>, <u>Clifford</u>, <u>Little Critter</u>, etc.). Talk about the experiences and adventures that the main character faces in each book.</p>
<p>Choice 3</p> <p>On Friday, the Italian food truck made 2 dozen pizzas. 1 dozen pizzas were cheese, 3 were pepperoni, and 3 sausage. The rest were vegetarian. Some of the vegetarian had peppers and the rest of the vegetarian ones had tomatoes. What combinations of vegetarian pizzas had peppers and did not have peppers?</p> <p>(Hint: 1 dozen = 12 pizzas, there is more than one answer).</p>	<p>Choice 3</p> <p>Read a just right book and think about the setting (place and time) of the story. Rewrite the story from a different setting.</p> <p>(ex. What would happen if Little Red Riding Hood walked through a rain forest instead of a forest?)</p>
