Make a list of the things you would do or write a story about your adventures with the Cat in the Hat.</p>	<p>Tuesday Dress up as your favorite book character! Who is your favorite book character and why?</p>
<p>Do you have any overdue library books? Bring them in on Thursday!</p>	<p>Draw a picture of your favorite Dr. Seuss character. Write sentences describing your character.</p>	<p>What would happen if Thing 1 and Thing 2 visited Wiley? What would they do? Where would they go? Draw and write about their adventures.</p>
